## **Making gifts go further**

Thanks to Gift Aid every pound given as a charitable donation can be worth 28 per cent more and at no extra cost to the donor. It's the smart way to give!

All you have to do is to complete a Gift Aid declaration, like the one below, to confirm that you are a taxpayer.

Thames Community Foundation will then reclaim this tax from the Inland Revenue for the benefit of the [Wimbledon Park Residents' Association Gift Aid Fund](#)

The more you give the more we can claim back. There is no fixed maximum amount.

If you are a higher rate taxpayer then the higher rate tax paid can also be claimed back through your tax return, which means that a donation of £10 can be worth £12.80 to the charity yet only cost £7.80.

### **Here's an example of how it works**

You decide to give £50 to support Wimbledon Park Residents' Association.

Just complete the Gift Aid declaration below and send it with your cheque to Thames Community Foundation.

Thames Community Foundation claims back the £14.10 tax you have paid, turning your gift into £64.10. Thames will then credit this amount to Wimbledon Park Residents' Association Fund with a note of your name and address –unless you wish to remain anonymous. Thames Community Foundation will also write to you confirming the transaction and giving you a note of your donation in case you need this for your tax return.

### **Higher rate taxpayers benefit even more**

If you pay tax at the current higher rate (40 per cent) you can also claim a tax benefit for yourself by including this donation on your annual tax return. The difference between the basic and higher rate tax (i.e. 40 per cent less 22 per cent) can be deducted from your tax bill, so it saves you money too.
